

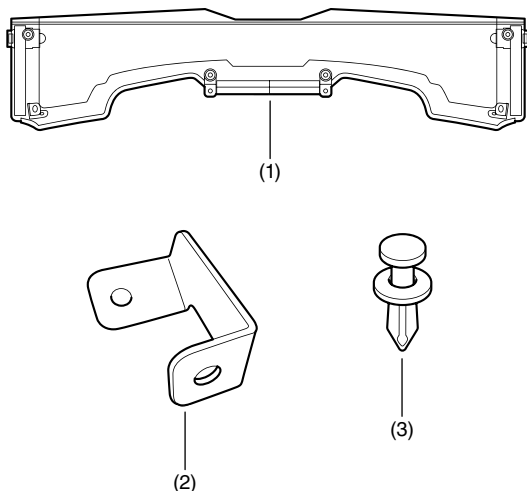

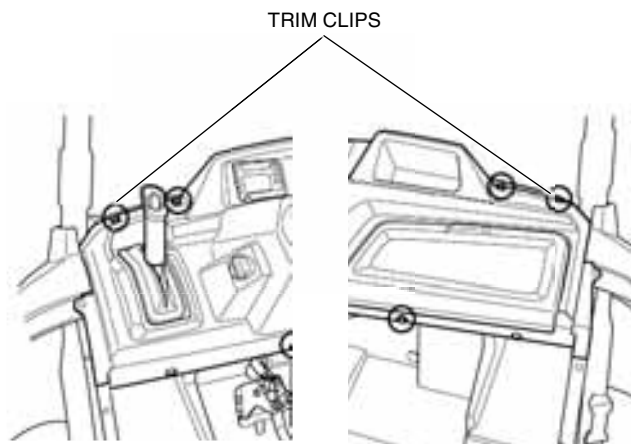
Power drill

USE AND CARE INFORMATION

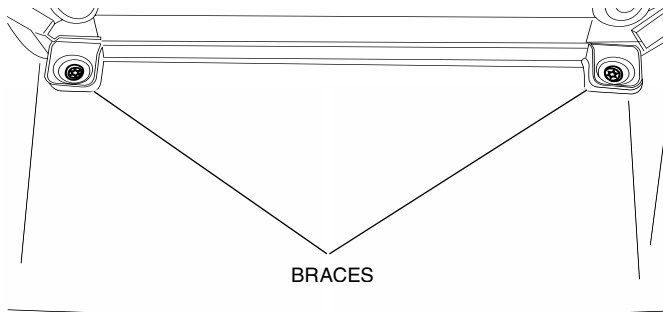
- Check the accessory mounts frequently and retighten if necessary.
- Replace this accessory with a new one if it is damaged or discolored excessively.
- When this accessory becomes dirty, rinse it thoroughly with cool water to remove loose dirt, and then wash with warm soapy water and a clean cloth or sponge.
- Do not use a brush to clean this accessory as it may scratch the surface.
- Never use petroleum solvents such as gasoline, thinner, and benzene, to clean this accessory. Also do not use acid or alkaline cleaners.

INSTALLATION

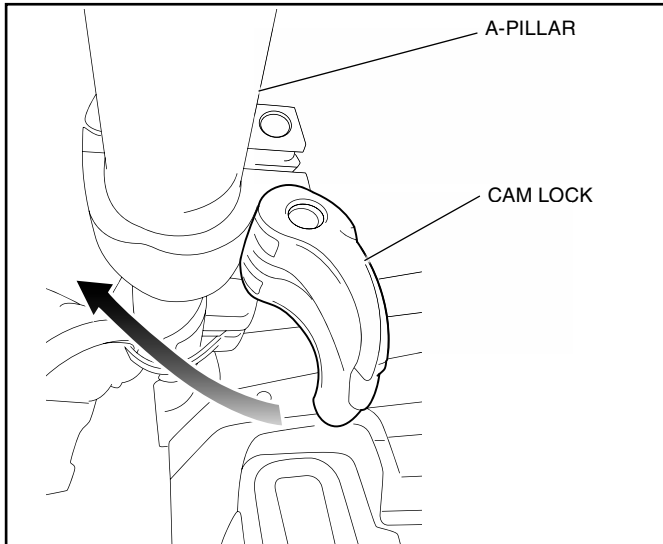
1. Remove the outer trim clips from the instrument panel as shown and save them for reuse.



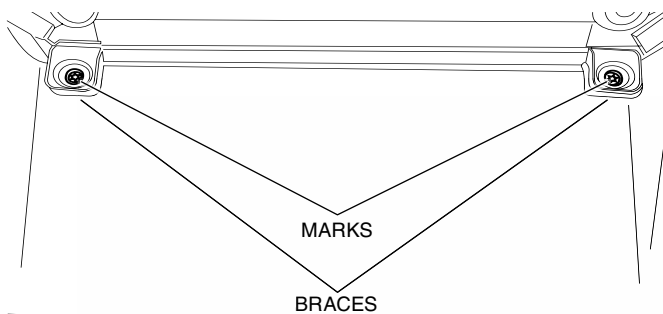
2. Place the wind deflector onto the vehicle and seat the bottom braces onto the front hood as shown. Push down on the wind deflector gently to be sure that its braces are seated securely.



3. Lock the two wind deflector cam-locks around the left and right cab frame A-pillars.
- Remove the rubber shipping spacer from the cam lock.

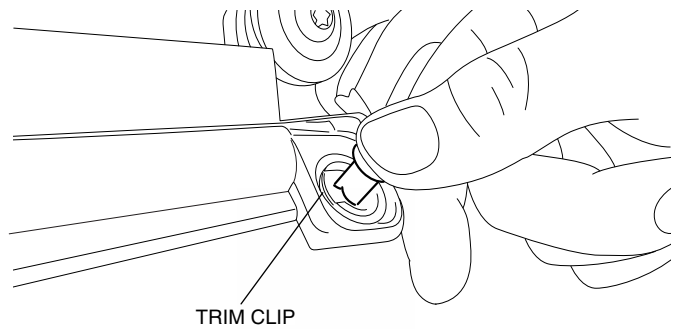


3. Using the wind deflector braces as a guide, make a mark on the front hood through the hole in the brace.



4. Remove the wind deflector and drill holes with a 9 mm (3/8 in) drill bit through the marks on the front hood.
5. Reinstall the wind deflector.

6. Lock the wind deflector into place onto the front hood by placing trim clips through the wind deflector braces and holes.



7. Install the angle brackets to the wind deflector using the included trim clips.
- Install the wind deflector/brackets to the instrument panel as shown using the trim clips removed in Step 1.
