

## TOOLS AND SUPPLIES REQUIRED

- Socket (8 mm)
- Ratchet
- Long nose pliers
- Grease
- Torque wrench

## TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.

Item	N·m	kgf·m	lbf·ft
5 mm bolt	5.2	0.5	3.8


## INSTALLATION

### ▲ CAUTION


- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

1. Pull down the left passenger footpeg as shown, and remove the split pin, washer, and pivot pin.


<Left side>




2. Remove the left passenger footpeg as shown.
  - Remove it carefully to prevent the steel ball and spring from jumping out.




- Assemble the step set plate and step rubber as shown.




- Install the assembled step rubber to the left footpeg arm as shown.



**Push the step rubber, and tighten the bolt while raising the step set plate as shown.**




- Apply grease to the positions shown.




- Install the spring, steel ball and step detent plate as shown.


- Hold down the step detent plate after the installation.




- Install the assembled left passenger footpeg while holding down the step detent plate.




- Apply grease to the pivot pin as shown.



9. Install the pivot pin, washer, and split pin as shown.



10. Check that the left comfort passenger footpeg is fixed at each position by moving it as shown.



11. Repeat on the right side.
